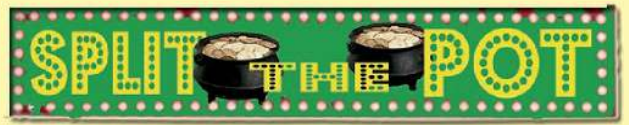
NOTES ABOUT LITURGY AND MUSIC FOR AUGUST (Part 2 of 2) From time to time, we rotate musical settings for the sung prayers common to all Sunday Masses (e.g., the Holy, Holy, Holy and the Lamb of God). Currently we are using the Mass of Creation by Marty Haugen, but in September we shall move to the Mass of Saint Ann by Ed Bolduc. The words will be posted on the monitors as usual, but, if you are interested, you can find the melodies in items 312 through 320 in the Gather 4 hymnal. The Mass of Saint Ann was most recently used at St. Teresa of Calcutta near the beginning of calendar year 2026, before the season of Lent. Today's Gospel (August 22/23) concerns the identity of Jesus, and some of today's songs speak to that. With To Jesus Christ Our Sovereign King, we affirm that our Lord and Christ is a victor, ruler, and redeemer. With O God Beyond All Praising, we acknowledge Jesus as "Christ, the man from heaven" and as our savior and king.
