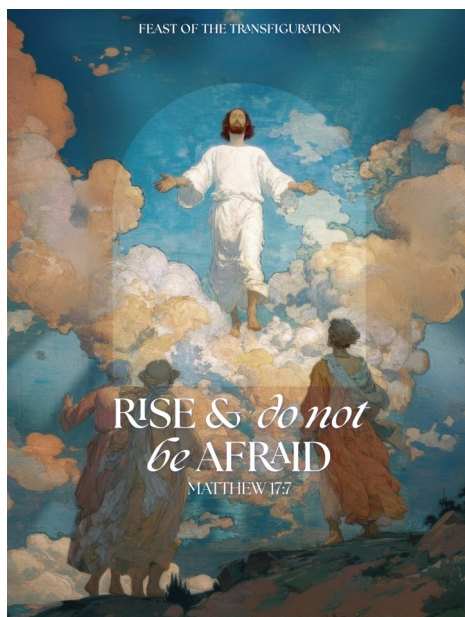

Liturgy & Music Notes for August By Richard Charnigo Music Director

Besides the Saturday and Sunday Masses, there are some holy days of obligation each year. In the Louisville Archdiocese, Immaculate Conception and Christmas are always holy days of obligation; Immaculate Conception is usually on Dec. 8th, but transfers to Dec. 9th in years when Dec. 8th is the second Sunday of Advent. Assumption (Aug. 15th), All Saints Day (Nov. 1st), and Solemnity of Mary (Jan. 1st) ARE Holy Days of Obligation unless they fall on a Saturday or Monday. This year, Aug. 15th falls on a Saturday, so the obligation to attend Mass does not apply. A theme for Catholic devotion in August is the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Given this, and because the Assumption is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year, we shall sing a couple of Marian hymns on Sundays this month: *Immaculate Mary (Aug. 8th/9th)* and *Hail Holy Queen Enthroned Above (Aug. 15th/16th)*



Little Way

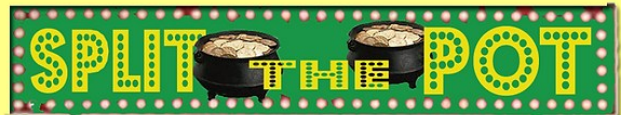
